### Meet the Honoree – Jacob Krause



Hello. My name is Jacob Krause and I am 10 years old. I am in the 5<sup>th</sup> grade at Clarksville Elementary School. One year ago I was diagnosed with ulcerative colitis.

Though it has been a very difficult year, my mom says that I got this disease because G-D knows that I am strong enough to handle it and motivated enough to do something about it. I think about colitis every day. Sometimes no one knows that it is on my mind and little things can worry me. When there is a field trip at school, I wonder if I will be able to go. In science class I wonder why no scientist has come up with a plan to help me. The future scares me because I don't want to have UC as an adult.

Even though this has not been easy, there have been positive things that I have realized since being diagnosed. I know my family is always there for me. I know I have wonderful doctors. I have found that I have a strong personality and can handle difficult situations. Most of all, I learned that just one person (even a ten year old boy) can really make a difference.....so together, **imagine what we can do!**
